## PE Days

#### Readina

We will be sending home your child's school reading book therefore it is important it is returned each day so your child can take part in group reading sessions at school.

#### **Tricky Words**

We will re-start sending Tricky Words home this week. If your child learnt to read all the Reception tricky words they will be started on the Year One sets. When you require a new set please ask your child to place them in the Tricky Word box in school. We do ask that you continue to learn to write the Reception sets too.

#### Maths

We will be continuing with the White Rose homework books, the children seem to have been really enjoying these! Please record any work you have been doing at home in your books. Please return your child's homework book in their book bag on a Thursday.

### **Phonics**

Phonics homework is sent each time we learn new graphemes for your child to practise the sounds they have been taught that week. Your child's Phonics homework does not need to be returned to school.

## Monday & Friday

Please continue to ensure your child attends school in a full PE kit, school colours (no football kits). Children are required to wear black trainers, which your child needs to be able to fasten themselves (we recommend velcro).

We will also be retelling the stories remembering capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.
