To begin our topic Mighty Machines, we will be using a short animation for inspiration when writing a setting. We will then move on to designing our own robots, describing their functions and features. The children will also look at the features and presentation styles of an explanation text. Finally, we will read our class novel <i>The Iron Man</i> by Ted Hughes and write a short sci-fi narrative exploring plot, character, and descriptions.	The children will begin the year exploring place value and recognising the value on digits in 3 and 4-digit numbers. The children will practise adding and subtracting mentally and by using written methods. Towards the end of the half term we will be consolidating the 2, 5 and 10 times tables, please continue to practise these at home.	As part of our Mighty Machines topic, we will be designing and creating a mechanism that could be used to make body parts move in a robotic animal. We will be exploring levers, linkages and pivots and their purpose and uses.	
Humanities	Science	Computing: E-safety	
In our history we will be exploring the Industrial Revolution and how this has shaped the area in which we live. We will visit buildings in our local area where machinery was a key feature of its purpose and compare how these buildings and machinery have changed over time.	In science we will explore why animals have muscles and a skeleton. We will also discuss whether they are vertebrates or invertebrates. We will be exploring how we move and identifying the main bones in our bodies.	We will begin the new school year by ensuring that the children understand about the importance of e-safety and how they can protect themselves and behave responsibly online.
