Curriculum			
English	Maths		Science
In English we will be working on persuasive letters and explanation texts linked to our topic. We will also be exploring elements of the Year Four grammar curriculum in meaningful contexts. We will continue to read our class book <i>The Explorer</i> and explore a range of other text types in our guided reading sessions.	In maths we will continue with adding and subtracting numbers with up to 4 digits using the formal written methods of column addition and subtraction where appropriate. Then we will explore area, before finishing the half term with multiplication and division and our times tables up to 12 x 12.		In science we are going to be exploring states of matter. We will be able to determine how states of matter change and are affected by different conditions. We will be able to identify the three states of matter, understand that materials can change states of matter when they are heated or cooled. We will also be looking at the stages of the water cycle.
Art	Music		Computing
In art we will be using Henri Rousseau paintings as inspiration to design and create our own artwork, experimenting with different effects and textures, including blocking in colour and washes.	The children will continue to develop their opera knowledge and skills. They will also be listening to, appraising and learning the songs in preparation for our Christmas concert.		This half term our computing sessions will follow the media strand of the curriculum. We will be researching our favourite rainforest animals and developing our skills to create a google slide presentation.
Other:			
We will explore colours, adjectives and body parts in French. In RE we will be exploring how important events are remembered in ceremonies. Our Crew sessions will continue to develop a greater understanding of the fundamental British values of Democracy, Rule of Law, Individual Liberty and Respect and Tolerance. We will also explore elements of our PSHE curriculum in crew with a focus on feelings, emotions and conflict resolution.
