Homework

Thank you for all your hard work with the children this year. There have been some amazing projects brought in which we have loved to see.

Our homework focus for the summer term will be **reading**. Please can we ask that you listen to your child read their reading book **several** times during the week. This is to promote automaticity and to ensure sounds are embedded.

Every child will change their reading book each week. Please continue to sign the reading record. We are looking for those star readers (read at least 5 times a week).

Children will continue to read with an adult in school three times a week in reading practice sessions.

We may send individual work home suited for your child if we feel they would benefit from more practise e.g. graphemes to learn, certain letter formations, number bonds to learn etc.

Please continue to read story books to your children - even as your children learn to read themselves. Being read to and discussing stories really develops a love of reading. There are some fantastic ebooks out there. Try this one.

English	Maths	Science
Text: Jack and THe Beanstalk Beanstalk We will be retelling the story. We will be remembering capital letters, finger spaces, full stops, question marks in sentences.	We will be learning our numbers up to 100 by counting forwards and backwards. We will be learning how to use a one hundred square. We will be learning how to partition, compare and order numbers to 100.	In science we will be looking at the plants that we can eat and having a taster session. We will also learn about germination and the life cycle of a plant by planting a bean. We will be measuring our bean plants over time. We will continue our observations of seasonal change and how this impacts on plant life.

As part of our topic work around castles we will be learning about famous kings and queens and the castles they lived in. We will be making comparisons between famous monarchs and looking at the similarities and differences.	In DT we will be looking at designing and making fruit kebabs. The children will learn about their senses in relation to food.	We are looking at keeping ourselves safe and logging into the chromebooks.
