Class Trays - The staff will have a tray in the mornings for the children to put in their files with their Reading Books (on their allocated day), any Tricky Words or Maths Challenges you need changing and any Show and Tell they might have.

Reading Books - Once we have assessed the children and Parents have been to the Phonics Workshop a book will be sent home with the child on their allocated day. On your child's allocated book change day (indicated on the reading record) can we ask you to place the reading book in the zipped wallet in the class tray in the morning ready to be changed. It is important children read their book/Tricky Words at least 5 times per week. If they do this they will receive a star in their reading log and we recognise their achievement in class with their peers.

Spare Clothes - Please use the tote bag you received from us to send in spare clothes, including socks and underwear, for your child to keep on their peg, in case they should need to get changed. Please make sure everything is named .
